


### Self-service Two-pot claim withdrawal process





To access two-pot system on Self Service platforms:

- A member must be registered with valid ID Number/Passport Number
- Up to date cellphone and email address
- Activate profile verification against
  Home Affairs system takes place
  every time a member login on all
  Self Service platforms. Once a date
  of death is registered a member's
  profile will be deactivated.



- When a member is
   authenticated, they will be able
   to see their snapshot view of
   their benefits.
- Access certain functionality based on authorization
- Profile (Member, Pensioner,
   Member with Pension
- benefit).












We will guide you through the process to make it as easy as possible to claim.



### **Rules: Savings Pot**

- The GEPF has 60 days from submission of a duly completed claim, to make payment. The GEPF will endeavour to pay this withdrawal as soon as possible.
- One withdrawal per tax year.
- Minimum withdrawal of R2 000 to maximum amount in the savings component benefit.
- Withdrawals taxed as gross income at the marginal rate.
- Claims Back Settings Home

   "Submit a Claim".











### **Rules: Savings Pot**

- The GEPF has 60 days from submission of a duly completed claim, to make payment. The GEPF will endeavour to pay this withdrawal as soon as possible.








- Member can scroll to select the amount they want to claim against.
