To: Deputy Directors-General, Chief Directors, Directors, Principals and Chairpersons of governing bodies of ordinary public schools and hostels (excluding colleges of education)

Short summary: Increase in amounts payable for boarding, transport and private boarding bursaries, and personnel subsidies to hostels and schools.

Subject: Increase in the amounts payable for boarding, transport and private boarding bursaries and personnel subsidies to hostels and schools

1. Approval has been granted for an increase in the following bursaries with effect from **01 April 2019:**
 - 1.1 The maximum boarding bursaries payable to needy learners in hostels attached to ordinary public schools have been increased from R8 974,00 to R9 460,00 per learner per annum.
 - 1.2 The maximum private boarding and transport bursaries payable to needy learners in the West Coast, Cape Winelands, Eden and Central Karoo, and Overberg Education Districts have been increased from R2 040,00 to R2 220,00 per learner per annum.
 - 1.3 NB – All of the above bursaries are calculated according to the approved test (see IMGP Minute 0001/2018, dated 09 March 2018) and criteria set out in Circular 0143/1998, dated 06 November 1998, and Circular 0029/2001, dated 13 March 2001.
2. Approval has also been granted for increases in the following personnel subsidies with effect from **01 April 2019:**
 - 2.1 The personnel subsidy payable to ordinary public schools with an enrolment of fewer than 201 learners, for the employment of administrative- and general services staff, has been increased from R586,00 to R620,00 per learner per annum. A minimum of R22 150,00 will be paid to a school.

- 2.2 The personnel subsidy payable to ordinary public school hostels with fewer than 50 boarders, for the employment of administrative staff, has been increased from R8 974,00 to R9 460,00 per learner per annum.
- 2.3 The personnel subsidy payable to church or private hostels, for the employment of administrative and cleaning services staff, has been increased from R2 045,00 to R2 160,00 per learner per annum.
