**Subject: Final timetable for the November 2022 National Senior Certificate examinations**

1. Enclosed is a copy of the **final** timetable (**Annexure A**) for the November 2022 National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations.
2. The examinations are scheduled to commence officially on **Monday, 31 October 2022** and conclude on **Tuesday, 06 December 2022**.
3. The Life Orientation (LO) Common Assessment Task (CAT) will be written on **Monday, 05 September 2022**.
4. The Computer Applications Technology (CAT) Paper 1 and Information Technology (IT) Paper 1 practical examinations will be written prior to the official commencement of the examinations on **25** and **26 October 2022** respectively.
5. Two sessions are scheduled for each day of the examinations. The morning session will commence at 09:00 and the afternoon session at 14:00.

6. Principals are to inform all full-time candidates writing the examinations that they must wear their school uniforms when writing every examination. Candidates must be available until the last day of the school term (14 December 2022), in case it should be necessary, for whatever reason, to reschedule the writing of a particular subject paper.
7. Please note that the recommended dates for the preparatory examinations are from **Monday, 12 September 2022**.
8. Normal classes must continue until **Friday, 21 October 2022** to ensure as much teaching time as possible and schools are encouraged to arrange a pledge ceremony for the day.
9. Your attention is drawn to the following important change in the management of candidates who miss a subject paper for any reason during the examination: these candidates will have to write all the subject papers for that specific subject in the subsequent May/June examination of the following year.
10. Kindly bring the contents of this circular to the attention of all candidates who intend to write the November 2022 NSC examinations.
