## Subject: eReadiness assessment within ordinary public and special schools

- 1. The Western Cape Education Department (WCED) is implementing an eStrategy over the next 10 years and this has been elevated to a Western Cape Government (WCG) eLearning Game Changer (GC) for focused attention over the next three years. As part of the WCED's ongoing strategy, an eReadiness assessment must be conducted across all ordinary public and special schools.
- 2. The purpose of the eReadiness assessment is to determine schools' current Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) status. This includes information on the existing ICT infrastructure, technology, policies and support in place to implement ICT integration and the current use of ICT.
- 3. The eReadiness assessment has three sections, each covered in a separate survey using the survey tool "Monkey Survey":
  - (a) a survey for principals on the technology available in the school;
  - (b) a questionnaire for principals; and
  - (c) a questionnaire for teachers.
