## Subject: Release of the curriculum Recovery Annual Teaching Plans for 2021

- 1. The Department of Basic Education (DBE) released **Circular \$13 of 2020** (**Annexure A**) on 11 December 2020. This national circular released the Recovery Annual Teaching Plans (ATPs) to be implemented in Grades 1 to 12 in 2021.
- 2. Circular \$13 of 2020 repeals and replaces Circular \$2 of 2020, which covered the revised and trimmed ATPs for implementation in 2020, and Circular \$3 of 2020, which covered the guidelines for implementing 2020 ATPs.
- 3. In order to mitigate the impact of COVID-19 on learning and teaching, the DBE adopted a multi-year curriculum recovery approach.
- 4. The Directorates Curriculum GET and FET will mediate the Recovery ATPs for Grades 1 to 12 in all subjects. The details of these mediation sessions will be communicated to schools by curriculum managers.
- 5. Further support in the implementation of the Recovery ATPs for 2021 will be provided by curriculum officials.
- 6. The Recovery ATPs for all subjects and grades are available on the DBE website: https://www.education.gov.za.

- 7. Your support in ensuring the effective implementation of the Recovery ATPs is appreciated.
- 8. Principals are requested to bring the contents of this circular to the attention of all teachers and ensure that all teachers attend the mediation sessions.
