**Subject: Support for FET learners during 2020 via telematics platform and live streaming**

1. The Western Cape Education Department (WCED) is offering lessons which are broadcast via an interactive telematics platform (lessons are beamed via satellite technology) during the period February–November 2020.
2. Over the past few years these lessons primarily targeted Grade 12 learners, hence a valuable and extensive database has been established for some subjects, covering especially Grade 12 content.
3. Candidates writing the National Senior Certificate Supplementary examinations in June can purchase support lessons on DVD at a nominal price from the WCED by calling Edumedia on tel. no. 021 689 9536.
4. The focus for 2020 will be on Grades 10, 11 and 12. See paragraph 7 below.
5. In addition to the broadcasts for Grades 10, 11 and 12, professional development sessions will be offered for History.
6. Since the timetable includes several subjects and different grades it is important that teachers and learners follow the timetable very carefully.
7. The following subjects will be offered:
  - English FAL (Grade 10 &12)
  - English HL (Grade 10 &12)
  - Physical Sciences (Grade 11 & 12)
  - Accounting (Grade 10 & 12)
  - Geography (Grade 10,11 & 12)
  - Mathematical Literacy (Grade 12)
  - Afrikaans HL (Grade 10 &12)
  - History (Grade 11 & 12)
  - Life Sciences (Grade 10 & 12)
  - Business Studies (Grade 11 & 12)
  - Mathematics (Grade 10, 11 & 12)
  - Economics (Grade 11& 12)

8. The attached Annexure A provides the timetable for lessons and topics.
9. The topics of the lessons will be printed in the learner booklets which will be provided to each learner in each of the subjects.
10. The presenters are lead teachers chosen for their expertise in their subjects.
11. Since lessons are conducted during the week, after school hours, it is important that principals discuss arrangements with their governing bodies and the parents of the learners.
12. Learner attendance will be monitored regularly by Head Office and district officials.
13. Principals will be expected to report quarterly on the attendance of learners, as well as successes or difficulties experienced with the programme.
14. In addition to the satellite broadcasts, all lessons are also live streamed. Schools who do not have satellite technology but have access to the broadband internet service are encouraged to take advantage of this free and excellent tutoring programme. Schools who wish to access the live streaming lessons and associated materials must register by contacting the Telematics helpdesk at tel. no. 021 808 9507 or 021 808 4129.
