Subject: Directorate eLearning Teacher Professional Development Programme (DEL TPD)

1. The eLearning thrust of the Western Cape Education Department (WCED) is intent on providing professional development opportunities focusing on digital teaching and learning for all WCED teachers and officials.
2. Digital teaching and learning describe educational practices that use appropriate digital tools and resources to strengthen a teacher's teaching and a learner's learning experience. The aim, therefore, is to enrich the achievement of curriculum learning objectives further.
3. The Capacity Building portfolio in the eLearning Directorate at Head Office, together with the eLearning advisory teams in the districts, is responsible to manage the DEL TPD rollout programme.
4. To assist in the growth of specific digital skills, a training menu focusing on four different developmental levels has been developed. The technology and pedagogy matrix can be viewed by using the following link:

5. These developmental levels are informed by the national guideline document, *Professional Development Framework for Digital Learning* (Department of Basic Education, 2018), and other learning theory models.
