CRITERIA FOR COMPETITION

1. Grades 1-3 entries must be a poster/drawing to illustrate the value of the library.

Criteria

- Only Grades 1-3 learners may enter.
- Poster/drawing must be on A4 paper.
- Name, surname, age, and grade must be clearly visible on the poster/drawing.
- It must be the learner's own work.
- It must be original and creative.
- Posters/drawings must be accompanied with a completed permission slip for the posters/drawings to be published in the media.

Guiding questions

- Illustrate what you love about your library; or
- In the case where there is no library at you school, what you would love to see happening in the library?
- 2. Grades 4-12 learners must write a **poem** based on the theme.

Criteria

- All poems must be the learner's own work.
- Name and surname, school name and grade must be clearly visible.
- Only one poem per learner will be accepted.
- The poem may be written in any style, rhymed or unrhymed.
- Maximum length must be 10-15 lines.
- All written entries must be legible.
- Poems must be accompanied with a completed permission slip for the poems to be published in the media.

Guiding questions

- How do school libraries help learners to get "#BackOnTrack" after the COVID-19 pandemic?
- If there is no school library, how would having one help learners get "#BackonTrack"?
- How would winning school library resources help your school?
