Subject:Roll out of a structured Afrikaans Home Language Literacy Programme based on the
Science of Reading in the Foundation Phase

- In 2019, the Western Cape Education Department (WCED) decided to follow a differentiated language approach for each of the three Home Languages in the province. This was based on the outcomes of the 2011–2019 Systemic Test results as well as the 2016 Progress in International Reading Literacy Study results.
- 2. In-depth research was done on the science of reading. This research led to a decision to follow a synthetic phonics approach to teach reading in the Foundation Phase.
- 3. In 2020, the WCED partnered with Funda Wande and collaboratively developed an Afrikaans Home Language programme for the Foundation Phase. The synthetic phonics approach is built into this programme.
- 4. The Funda Wande programme was piloted in 40 Afrikaans Language of Learning and Teaching (LoLT) schools in 2021 and extended to 50 more pilot schools in 2022.
- 5. The Funda Wande programme will be incrementally rolled out to all Foundation Phase classes at Afrikaans LoLT schools from 2023 to 2025. All Grade 1 teachers were trained in April 2023.
- 6. The programme aims to strengthen reading and comprehension in Afrikaans Home Language in the Foundation Phase. This forms part of the Western Cape's reading strategy and WCED's five-year strategic plan.
- 7. This minute serves to notify schools that all Grade 2 teachers will receive training and classes will be included in the roll-out in 2024.



- 8. Grade 2 teachers will be trained from 12–14 December 2023. All Grade 2 teachers teaching Afrikaans Home Language and departmental heads in the Foundation Phase are required to attend the training.
- 9. Districts will communicate the details and venues of this training in advance.
