## Subject: Suggested bridging strategy for learners from Grade 3 to Grade 4

- 1. Progressing to a new school phase can often be a traumatic experience for learners. With younger learners it seems even more challenging. The Western Cape Education Department (WCED) is concerned that with the background of learning losses, bridging from Grade 3 to 4 may pose a huge challenge for learners in 2024.
- 2. The Directorate: Curriculum General Education and Training of the WCED has also identified development and support to Grade 4 learners and teachers in 2024 as a high priority objective. The first level of development and support will focus on the smooth transition of learners from Grade 3 to Grade 4, followed by guidance and support to Grade 4 teachers in 2024.
- 3. The process will commence in Term 4 with suggested structured bridging and will be unpacked to guide different levels and stages:
  - Term 4 of 2023 planning;
  - Preparations for the week of 27 November 2023;
  - The handover process of learners from Grade 3 to Grade 4 teachers;
  - Preparations for the Grade 4 Open Day for learners;
  - Procedure on the Open Day; and
  - Mediation of the Grade 4 parent booklet.
- 4. The bridging process is explained in detail in **Annexure A.**

5. Principals are kindly requested to bring this minute to the attention of School Management Teams and Grade 3 and 4 teachers.
