

(i) Section C:

- (a) Fewer candidates lost marks this year through not reading the instructions properly.
- (b) SG Candidates prepare two books, but answer Question 1 and Question 2 on only ONE of the two books.
- (c) Write the TITLE of the BOOK next to the number of the question, e.g.:
*Umbuzo 1 : **Amathunzi Obomi** OR *Umbuzo 2 : **Ukujuxuza ngochulumanco.****
- (d) The paragraph answer to Question 2 must be 40 – 60 words in length and at least five relevant facts must be given in full sentences. It must be a description of a person's role or an event.
- (e) If specific questions are asked in the title question, then marks will be deducted if those are not answered.
- (f) Look at the mark allocated to a question. 2 marks = 2 facts.
- (g) At *Umbuzo 2* candidates were expected to use paragraphs instead of listing facts.
- (h) Quote **three words** if one word is required, otherwise marks are subtracted, e.g. "*de bangabi nesente*".(D 1.8)
- (i) It was clear that the HG candidates knew *Ukujuxuza ngochulumanco* well, although some candidates struggled with *Xola Tandokazi*. Some SG candidates struggled to express themselves in Xhosa.

(ii) Section D:

- (a) Candidates have to do all the comprehension tests.
- (b) Because instructions were not read, some candidates did not complete or even attempt this section, which cost them a lot Of marks.
- (c) Most of the HG candidates answered this section very well. Some SG candidates, however, could not understand very basic questions.
- (d) Marks were deducted for direct quotations from the passage. Generally, the indirect reason must be used.
- (e) Do not quote or guess in the hope of including the correct answer by accident.
- (f) Use own words, unless instructed to quote.
Incorrect answer: Direct quotation of the relevant paragraph.
- (g) Sentences start with a capital letter and end with a punctuation mark.
- (h) SG candidates must pay attention to basic grammar, especially the use of the subject, the possessive concords and other basic grammar structures, e.g:
Umsebenzi kaJane.
 1. **Kumabonakude.**
 2. *Bahambe ngenqwelo-moya.*
 3. *Babhatala ngetsheki.*
 4. **Yitreyini ehamba phantsi komhlaba.**
