

Drawing conventions must be taught to the candidates and not only certain drawings. This will enable the candidate to answer any question.

Question1: Freehand of cell phone

This question is well answered.

There are still centers (few) who's candidates used instruments to either determine the degrees or to draw the complete drawing. Some candidate placed the front view on the wrong side in the isometric view. Candidates must be taught the difference between a freehand drawing and a freehand sketch. (single lines vs many lines)

Question 2: Perspective of a room

The question was well answerd.

There were a big improvement in the determined the correct vanishing points. Candidates still do not realize that if the top view is touching the picture plane that the same point will touch the ground plane.

Question 3.: Conventions / Sectional View

There is a wast improvement in the answering of conventions. Most of the candidates knew the basics of the conventions. Few could apply the measurements correctly. Some did not read the question properly and did not attempt the measurements.

Question 4: Assembly of a hand drill

This question was well answered by those with insight . Few candidates could do the partial hatching around the pin. Knurling of the chuck was not don properly.
