

Most candidates completed the question paper, but score low marks due to lack of concentration, exercise and poor accuracy.

There is a clear indication that they have been taught adequately, although quite a number of candidates were unable to pass or reach and pass the speed limit.

Some candidates find it difficult to interpret certain manuscript signs, but accuracy was once again the biggest problem and therefore the main factor for candidates to fail the paper. There were, however, also candidates who obtained excellent marks. Specific centres could not be pointed out clearly.

We, the Moderator, Examiners and Markers have no doubt in the Standard of the Question Paper and agreed that it was fair. Candidates were never disadvantaged and adjustments were made where needed. We therefore recommended that the raw marks be accepted as is.
