QUESTION 6

The question on the concept "God the Father" was poorly answered. Teachers must give special attention to this section of the syllabus.

QUESTION 7

The candidates confused the Second Commandment with the First Commandment.

QUESTION 8

This question on the Holy Spirit at work through the fellowship of believers was poorly answered.

RECOMMENDATIONS

More attention and guidance must be given to the ABET centres and to candidates that offer Biblical Studies as a seventh subject.
