SECTION A (SHORT QUESTIONS)

1. Some candidates gave their own interpretation and not the requested RASHI interpretation.
2. Some candidates gave only one of two required answers for the Pshat, while some did not relate at all to the Drash.
3. This question was generally well-answered, however, some candidates did not present Rashi's interpretation of the verses.
4. In the second section of this question, some of the candidates did not refer to the contradiction in the text.
5. This question was well-answered.
6. Most candidates focused on the notion of resting on shabbat and did not refer to the concept of the shabbat as a day of spiritual engagement.
7. Many candidates answered this question incorrectly
8. This question was well-answered, but some candidates confused "Lo tachmod" with "Lo tin'af" and some did not explain the significance of "Lo tachmod".

Questions 9, 10 and 11 were well answered.

Question 12: Isaiah was afraid that he might die as he had seen G-d, but some candidates wrote that he was afraid because he was impure, and did not explain why this impurity would have given him cause to fear.

Questions 13 and 14 were well answered.

Question 15: Most candidates did not explain the simile well.

SECTIONS B, C, D (ESSAY QUESTIONS)

Most essays were well-written and related to the question asked. Candidates displayed a good knowledge of their networks.
