

**GENERAL**

The majority of candidates answered the question paper satisfactorily.

**ESSAYS:**

1. Most of the candidates attempted two essay questions because they had no difficulty in interpreting these questions.
2. Most candidates were penalized for faulty structuring of the essay (introduction, body and conclusion).

**SOURCE- BASED QUESTIONS**

Generally speaking, the source- based questions were answered well.

1. Candidates found the interpretation questions difficult and often simply copied the sources into their answer books.
2. Candidates battled to extract relevant information from the sources in order to write a relevant paragraph.
3. The candidates who attempted Question 6 on The Cold War displayed little knowledge of this period. .
