

Question 1

Fairly well answered, although some centres fared poorly because of candidates' reading problems.

Question 2

Generally poorly answered, few candidates scored high marks. Part of the question was fairly easy and 40% of the mark was allocated for copying a sketch and doing circle division.

Question 3

Fairly well answered. Candidates appeared to have done many of these drawings during their school careers.

Question 4

This question looked difficult. Candidates had to assemble a variety of parts and those who copied the parts and assembled them correctly scored high marks. The weaker candidates were credited for each part they copied correctly. The method of "marking with error" was applied and the candidate was penalised by only half a mark for each error. An error that affected other parts was penalised by only half a mark and the candidate was then awarded the remainder of the marks.

Some candidates were unable to complete the paper within the time allowed.
