

**SECTION A**

**Question 1**

- 1.1 Generally well answered, especially the time signature. The most common error was not grouping the quavers correctly.
- 1.3 Difficult. Very few candidates could answer this question correctly.
- 1.4 and 1.5 Generally well answered – most mistakes were due to haste on the part of candidates.
- 1.6 Generally well answered.

**Question 2**

- 2.1 and 2.2 Generally well answered.
- 2.3 Several candidates did not understand the question. Candidates wrote the solfa notation for the soprano line. Many candidates were unsure of the rhythmic and pitch aspects of solfa notation.

**Question 3**

- 3.1 Many candidates were not sure about the structure of the pentatonic scale. The descending scale also confused quite a few candidates. Candidates were also unsure about whether to include the top octave note or not.
- 3.2 Candidates should read carefully. There was also confusion between F and F sharp major.
- 3.3 Some confusion about the number of notes in this scale. Some candidates included the octave note and some did not.

**Question 4**

Most candidates had problems identifying the key of the melodies. Most opted for the violin melody, but were confused by the b flat, which was only an accidental.

**Question 5**

The answers ranged from excellent to very weak. The late beginners had not acquired the necessary skills.

**SECTION B**

**Question 6**

- 6.1 Many could not compare, but the content was generally satisfactory.
- 6.2 Only a few candidates realised that South African jazz history also had to be discussed.

**Question 7**

- 7.1 Generally well answered
- 7.2 Generally well answered, but candidates could not always highlight the Romantic characteristics of the music, often giving only a description of the work or telling the story.

**Question 8**

Generally well answered, but candidates did not always read the questions properly, therefore losing marks because they forgot to mention a work and/or the composer.

**Question 9**

Answered well, but candidates should stick to the style characteristics of the music.

**Question 10**

Well answered.

**Question 11**

Satisfactory answers.

**Question 12**

Most candidates answered Question 12.1 (Khumalo) – this was generally well answered. Question 12.2 (Van der Watt) was not answered well and 12.3 (Khosa) was the least popular.

**Question 13**

Well answered.

**Question 14**

Instructions on the question paper were vague, resulting in candidates not indicating their choice of work. Many candidates did not answer this question.

**Question 15**

Well answered – most candidates could give Mickey advice on what he or she should do.
