

Candidates did very well. Congratulations are due to both candidates and teachers who devoted their time to promoting our language. There is, however, a general need to improve on the analysis of poetry.

KAROLO A (Poetry) Pulamadiboho

This section was poorly answered. Many candidates did not have the ability to analyse poetry in a systematic manner. Teachers need to concentrate on the inclusion of skills relating to author's views, voice, imagery and figurative language. Drilling in the appropriate techniques would have ensured a better performance.

KAROLA B (Novel) Mme

Most candidates did fairly well. Candidates displayed knowledge and understanding of the book. A few performed poorly because they did not adhere to the instructions and, consequently, made the wrong question choice. Candidates' popular choice was Question 11 and they answered it very well. This was encouraging.

KAROLO C (Drama) Seyalemoya

Most candidates did fairly well. Unfortunately, there were some candidates who attempted the essay, Question 13, without having read the story. Their essays were thin and vague. Teachers must prepare their candidates for this examinations. Question 14 was a popular choice and was answered very well.
