

**SECTION A**

**KUSA KUSIHLWA**

Candidates did well in this section. In many centres there were no blank spaces. It seems that teachers equipped them well for the exam

**UMQOL'UPHANDLE**

Question 3, an essay question, was not well answered by almost all the centers. Candidates did not answer the question. Instead, they wrote everything they knew about the book and, as a result, scored poorly for content. Teachers are advised to go through this question with next year's candidates to ensure that the same mistake does not occur again .

**SECTION B: NDIYEKENI**

Question 5 (essay question) was poorly answered. Candidates did not understand the meaning of the phrase 'lthambo lenyoka lihlab'elimzondayo'. Teachers are advised to spend more time on idioms and proverbs to prepare candidates for this section. Candidates who answered Question 6, which was a contextual question, did well.

**SECTION C:**

This section was answered only by candidates who answered questions on all the books, which indicates that these candidates did not follow the instructions. Teachers need to emphasize the importance of reading the instructions before attempting to answer any paper. They also need to be told to choose only the two books that they have studied during the year. Otherwise, they end up losing marks, as only the answers to the first two questions are marked.

**SECTION D: VUKANI MADODA KUSILE**

This section was answered by almost all the centres. Some candidates did well and some did not. It seems that teachers need to give more attention to this section.
