 - 4. Whether there is an alarm system in the
 - Administration block
 - Classrooms
 - 5. Whether the alarm is in working order and connected to an armed response company.

What service does the Call Centre provide?

Access:

The toll-free line will be open from **Mondays to Fridays** between **8:00 am and 7:30 pm**. Weekend calls will be recorded and responded to on Monday mornings.

Language preference:

Call Centre operators will be able to speak to you in Afrikaans or English or Xhosa

Referral agency:

We provide initial on-line counselling for callers who need help. The Centre also acts as a referral agency for trauma counselling, assualts, rape and teenage runaways.

Networking:

The Centre currently networks with the Department of Welfare, psychologists and other relevant service providers in an attempt to create a safe learning environment at schools.
