

## HEBREW HG PAPER 2

Section A (Short questions): In general, these questions were answered well. However, Questions 4 and 5 were not fully answered by many candidates. Question 4: Many candidates were not able to present Rashi's interpretation of the verse, as required by the question. Question 5: Most candidates were able to give only one of two possible interpretations of the text.

Section B and C (Tanach and prose) : All the questions in both these sections were well-answered.

Section D (Poetry) : Most candidates answered the poetry questions well. However, in question 1 (Al Hashchitah), some candidates appear to have been taught that this poem can be seen as a poem that culminates in hope. This interpretation is difficult to support through the text, which implies the opposite.
