NDITA, J:

Having read the papers filed of record, and having heard argument from counsel for the parties as well as the *amicus curiae*, it is ordered as follows.

[2] That the Respondent and its affiliated members are interdicted and restrained from issuing threats to the Applicants, service providers, learners and members of the public to the effect that they (the respondent) will obstruct, interfere and stop the transporting of learners within the Western Cape.

[3] The Respondent is ordered to pay costs.
